WHAT:

The three unions participating in Wednesday's rally aim to educate the public and Members of Congress about Amtrak's actions to cut and outsource its workforce. Under the leadership of President and CEO Richard Anderson, Amtrak's labor relations have taken a hostile turn, and proposed service route changes threaten transportation access for millions. This change is detrimental not only to the employees, but to Amtrak's service to the traveling public.

The Transportation Communications Union (TCU/IAM), the Transport Workers Union (TWU), and Unite-HERE -- representing service, clerical, and maintenance craft employees at Amtrak -- have been under attack recently. Amtrak's new leadership is seeking any-and-all ways to outsource work away from its own skilled, unionized workforce.
