The Cost of Wages & Fringe Benefits

For A Railroad Clerk



The figures shown below illustrate the per-employee per-month cost to a railroad employer for the wages and benefits provided to each Railroad Clerk effective January 1, 2023. The computations are based on the average national rate of \$38.19 per hour, and a work-year of 2,335 average composite straight-time equivalent hours. Hours include straight-time, overtime (at 1.5 ST hours for each OT hour) and all hours paid for time not worked such as vacation, personal leave, jury duty, bereavement, etc.
